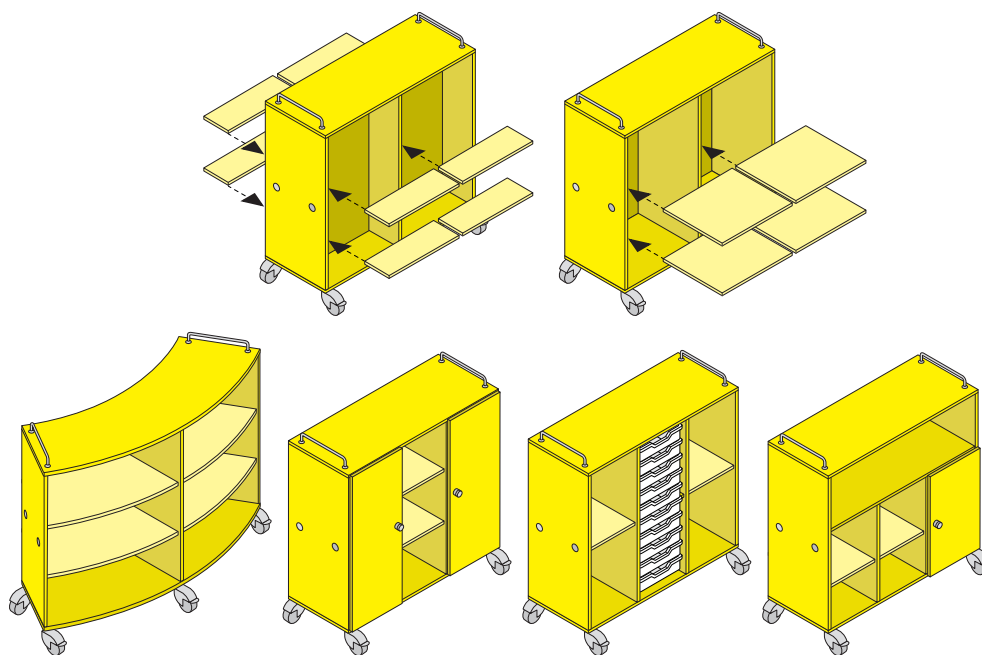

Instructions for Use

Shift+ Landscape (cabinet modules)

Intended use: Mobile cabinet modules for schools, colleges, seminars and further education establishments. No liability will be assumed for any use other than that intended. For use in closed premises.

Maximum load per cabinet: 150 kg. Shelves correspond to load group L75 as per DIN 68874-1.

Maximum load per materials box: 5 kg

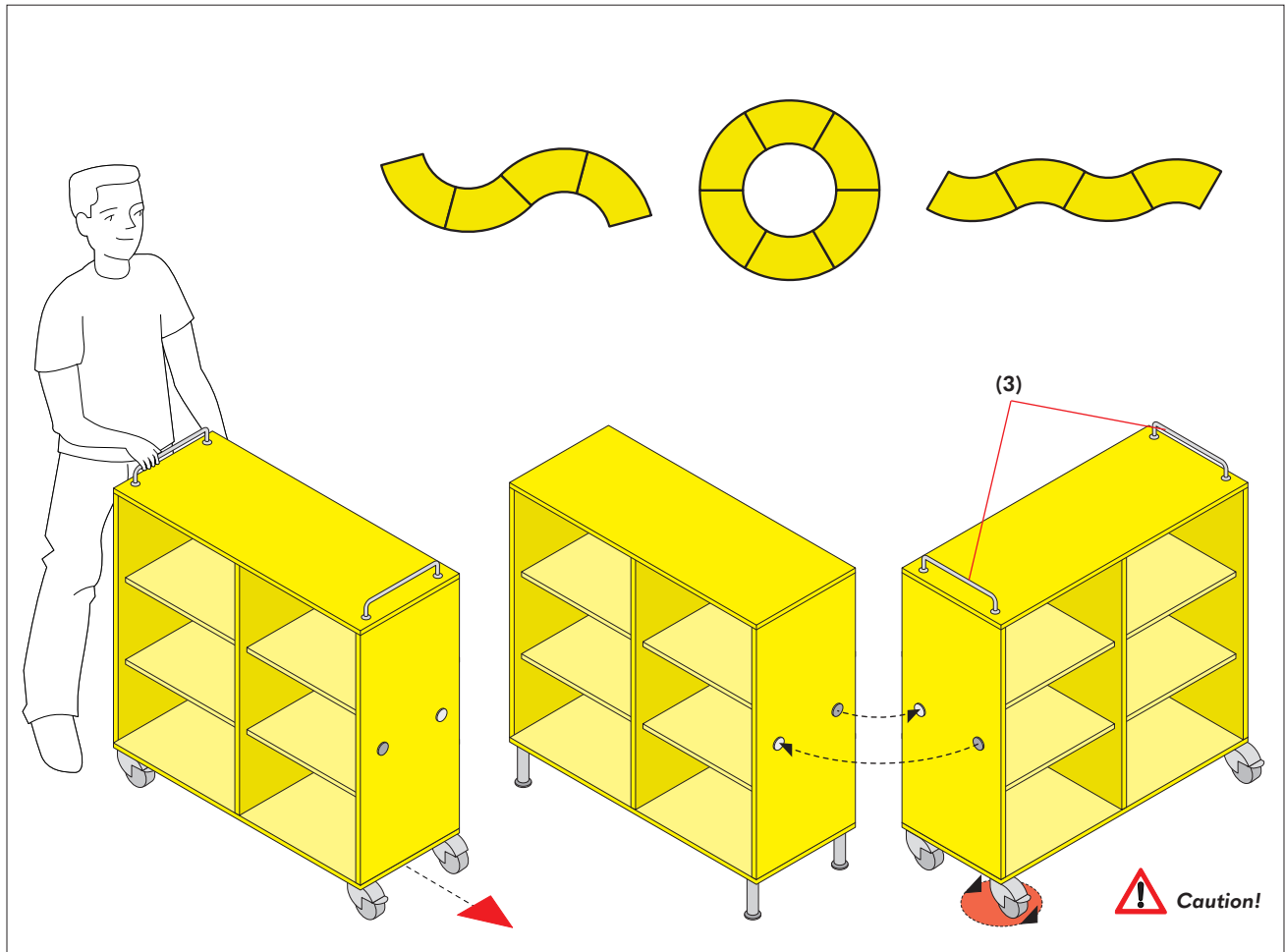

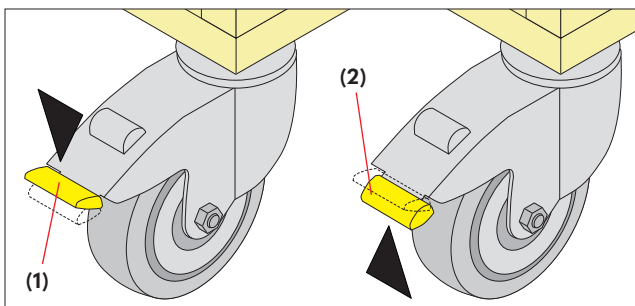


1. Mobility:

Shift+ cabinet modules may optionally be equipped with castors. Units may only be wheeled on their castors if the top shelf is empty.

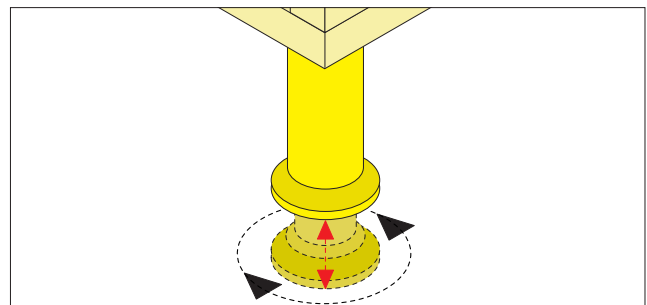
2. Castors (optional):

Release the lock (1), so that you can wheel the body. Press the mechanism down again (2) to lock the castors after moving the unit to a new location.



3. Adjustable feet (optional):

Stationary Shift+ cabinet modules may optionally be equipped with adjustable feet to compensate for uneven floors.



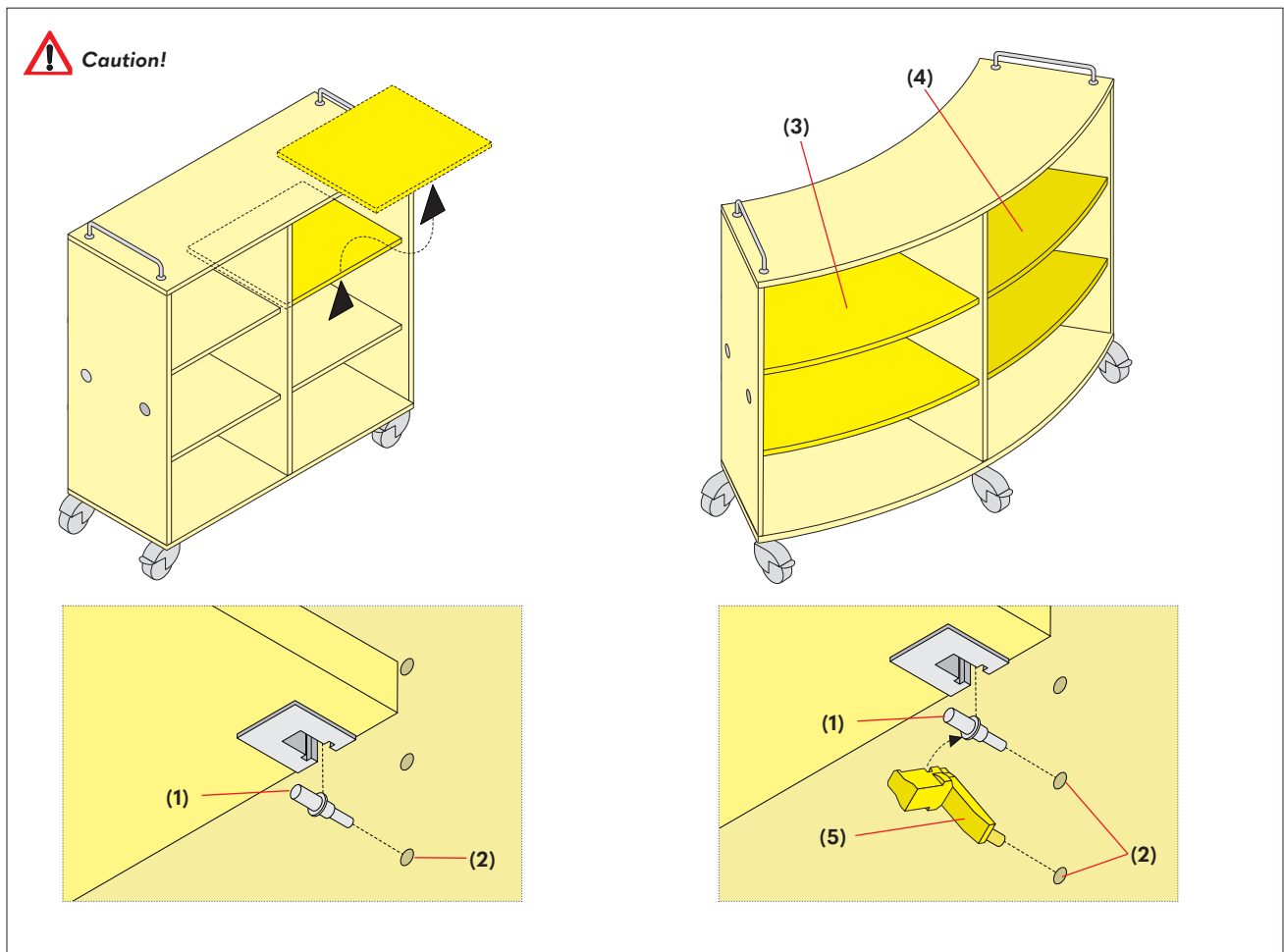
4. Connectors (optional):

If mobile Shift+ cabinet modules are placed next to one another in a row then they are fixed together by means of magnetic discs on their sides. These are used as positioning aids and keep the modules in position.

Caution! The castors are subject to wear – please check and replace at regular intervals.

Caution! To ensure stability, the rollers must always be locked every time the unit is moved to a new location.

Caution! Danger of tripping as castors may protrude forwards!



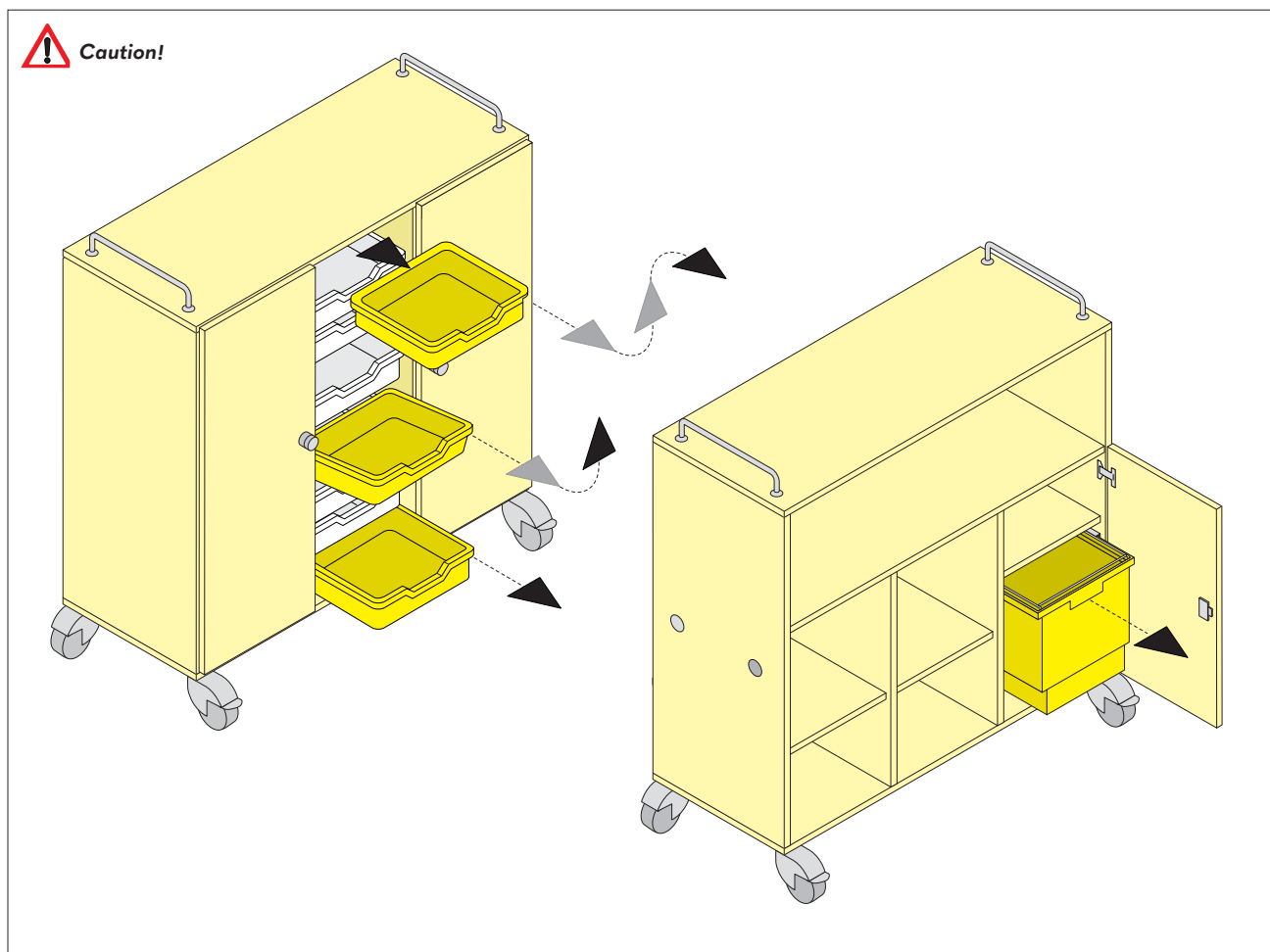
5. Sliding handles (3) (optional)

6. Shelves:

To move a shelf, lift it forwards in the middle by a maximum of 25 mm until it is clear of the shelf carrier (1). The shelf can then be lifted out at the rear edge. Remove the shelf carrier from the hole (2) and then press it into a hole at the required position. Then insert the shelf from above.

Caution! In the models 45292, 45293, 45304, 45305, 45306, 45307, the shelves on the left (3) and right (4) are different and are not interchangeable.

Shelves for 60° elements have additional supports.



7. Mobile cabinet modules with closing swing doors for use in specialist rooms:

Caution! When the doors are opened and closed, it is possible for items or fingers to become trapped between the door and the side of the unit. If the units are used in teaching establishments then their use must be supervised and the doors must be closed after use.

8. Removing the materials boxes:

Pull the boxes forwards as far as the stop and then lift them until they pass above the pull-out lock. You can then remove the box.

Inserting: Insert the boxes from above until they are correctly positioned in the guide rail. Then push them in horizontally as far as the stop.

Caution! If cabinets are equipped with materials boxes then these boxes must be fully inserted before the units are moved.

Caution! Only pull one box out forwards at any one time.
