Cleaning and maintaining glass surfaces.

General information: In general, glass surfaces do not require intensive cleaning. Simply wipe away any slightly soiled areas with a moderately moistened cloth or sponge. Eliminate any dirtier areas with water and a commercially available glass cleaner.

Do not use any aggressive and/or abrasive cleaning materials since these can damage the glass surface. These also include all liquid cleaners which contain abrasive additives such as whiting or similar.

Only use **cleaning cloths, rags, or natural or synthetic sponges** for cleaning. Do not use any synthetic or steel wool cleaning pads. These can permanently damage the surface structure. After cleaning, wipe moisture off the glass surfaces with a rubber squeegee and then wipe with a dry cloth.

Use suitable mechanical aids (e.g. scraper) to loosen any **difficult-to-remove or adhering dirt** such as splashes of paint before cleaning.
