Cleaning and maintaining polypropylene seat shells.

General information: When used as intended, polypropylene chair components typically require minimal maintenance. Simply clean any slightly soiled areas with a moderately moistened cloth or sponge. In the case of more serious dirt, a gentle household or neutral cleaner can be added to the water.

Do not use any aggressive and/or abrasive cleaning materials since these can damage the surface. These also include all liquid cleaners which contain abrasive additives such as whiting or similar.

Only use **cleaning cloths, rags, or natural or synthetic sponges** for cleaning. Clean any recesses with a soft brush. Do not use any synthetic or steel wool cleaning pads. These can permanently damage the surface structure.

If possible, remove any **marks** made by ballpoint pens, felt pens, marker pens etc. before they dry in.

Note: Staining can sometimes occur on light-colored surfaces caused by non-colorfast textiles, e.g. dark denim. If denim fabrics leave color marks on the polypropylene shell even after repeated washing, this is demonstrably a defect in the clothing fabric and is not due to the quality of the seat shell.
