Cleaning and maintaining veneered and lacquered surfaces.

General information: Veneered and lacquered surfaces do not require any intensive cleaning. The UV-hardened acrylic resin lacquered coats (water-based UV lacquer) ensure easy maintenance. It is advisable to be careful, in particular in the case of hard, rough, pointed, or sharp-edged objects such as, for example, protective studs or buckles on briefcases. Solvent-based substances (e.g. including nail varnish) can also damage the lacquer.

Standard maintenance: Regularly dry-wipe table surfaces and, in addition, also occasionally wipe with a soft, damp cloth (use household detergent sparingly). Then rub over with a dry cloth.

If possible, wipe away **spilled liquids** (water, coffee, tea etc.) with a soft dry or slightly moistened cloth. Always wipe over again with a dry cloth.

Do not use any hard or rough cloths (including microfiber cloths), aggressive or abrasive cleaning agents or solvents.

These can damage the veneered or lacquered surfaces.
